Military appreciation night tweaked

Armed Forces Appreciation Night will begin at 6:45 p.m. Sept. 4 after organizer Dave McIlrath and West Branch Community School District Activities Director Carrie Viel worked out additional details last week. All veterans and active-duty personnel will get into the game free. Viel encouraged veterans supporting either the Regina and West Branch varsity football teams at Friday night’s Little Rose Bowl game to respond when the announcer invites them to come down to the Butch Pedersen Field for recognition. Volunteers will ask other audience members from both teams to hold flags along the sidelines with



the intent of surrounding the field in red, white, and blue. The West Branch High School marching band will perform patriotic music and paratroopers will jump out of an airplane to coincide with the National Anthem, landing on the field and presenting game balls to two veterans from World War II. Vocal music instructor Christopher Reed will sing Billy Ray Cyrus’ “Some Gave All.” The players will wear special military-themed jerseys with camoflaug trim and military patches to honor family members who served. Viel said about 30 players will wear patches to honor family members who served. “I’m excited to see how it goes,” the first-year AD said. “Dave has done a phenomenal job raising money to pay for the jumpers, flags, and patches – all paid by donations.” The West Branch American Legion Chauncey Butler Post 514 will present the colors.
